



BE ELECTION READY ELECTION DAY IS TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8TH



Election Day is Tuesday, November 8th. On this day, voters across the nation will select the new President of the United States, as well as representatives at the federal, state and local level. Voters in Florida will also have items such as constitutional amendments and county referendum items for consideration. City of Weston voters will select a new Commissioner for Seat 1, and will also have an amendment to the City's charter for consideration.

Vote-By-Mail

In order to vote-by-mail (formerly known as *absentee ballot*) voters must submit a request in writing. The request can be made in person, by mail, by telephone, or you can [fill out a request form now](#). Only the voter or a designated member of his or her immediate family or legal guardian can request an Vote By Mail ballot for the voter. Immediate family means the voter's spouse, parent, child, grandparent, or sibling of the voter or of the voter's spouse. Requests must be received by the Broward Supervisor of Elections Office no later than November 2, 2016.
