This November, Broward County residents have the opportunity to vote on two ballot questions that represent two half-penny surtaxes in Broward County:



-Half Penny to fund countywide transportation system, and

CITIZEN OBSERVER PATROL (C.O.P.) PROGRAM

A model program, COP's are the additional eyes and ears of the community, assisting and enhancing our own BSO policing efforts. Members of the Broward Sheriff's Office of Countywide Operations professionally train all volunteers. Typical assignments in addition to patrol, include performing checks on unoccupied residences at owner's request, checking on elderly or homebound and reporting potential problems and neighborhood hazards and assist at Weston community events.






WESTON GOVERNMENT RADIO 1680AM
